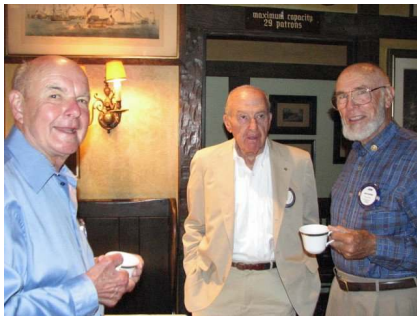

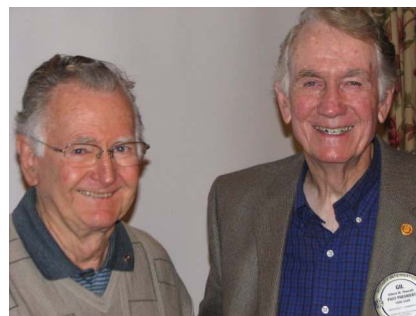

2. Create a 5-year plan.
3. Brainstorming
4. Short action plans
5. Achieving goals through effective plan process.

They are promoting the concept to Clubs and having the Clubs schedule a Vision Team. All members are to complete a Rotary Vision Questionnaire. The Vision Team meets under controlled circumstances, which Kim DeBroux explained.
