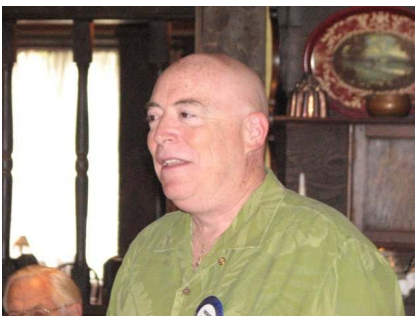
Christina Holliday reminded members that due and pledges are due before the end of the fiscal year.

More than 13,000 cases of domestic violence will be reported in Orange County this year. The Family Violence Project, in collaboration with the Orange County Superior Court, seeks to increase public awareness of issues surrounding domestic violence, teen relationship abuse and child abuse through innovative education programs and specialized training targeted to clergy members, educators and teens.
