### Newport Beach City Manager

Cynthia Cowell introduced her boss Homer Bludau, City Manager of Newport Beach and a fellow Texan. Mr. Bludau has been City Manager for 10 years and is retiring. His replacement will be announced in the next 3 days.

His first topic was the State budget. The state is borrowing from local governments and which must be paid off within 3 years with interest. Newport Beach is in good shape financially because the City has a general reserve of about \$75 Million.

Next he spoke about the City Hall building, which is on track. Plans should be completed in November for City Council review. It will take 2 ½ to 3 years before the city Hall will be relocated in what is to be known as "City Hall in the Park."

The airport issue was his next topic. There is an air quality study being prepared. The FAA nationwide is trying to make air space more efficient.

There was a question and answer period. Since Mr. Bludau is a former Rotarian, Tom Birch extended an invitation for Mr. Bludau to rejoin Rotary. He is a Paul Harris Fellow
