If you wish to **invite a Marine to share your Thanksgiving dinner** you can sign up with Laura Dietz.

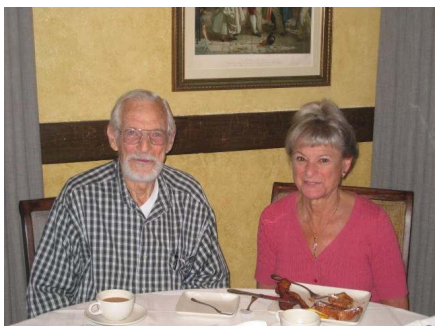

Bill Robbins introduced Dr. Kris Iyer, newly appointed Medical Director of the Mary & Dick Allen Diabetes Center at Hoag Hospital. Dr. Iyer has been with Hoag Hospital for 26 years.

Dr. Iyer is himself a Type I diabetic. Mr. Allen's granddaughter was diagnosed as a type I diabetic at the age of 2, which what started his passion for helping diabetics who do not have the same advantages as those with influence and money. From cradle to the grave, diabetes is a public health issue. Did you know that \$174 Billion is currently spent in taking care of the diabetic population? Dr Iyer believes that figure will grow to \$300 Billion.
