

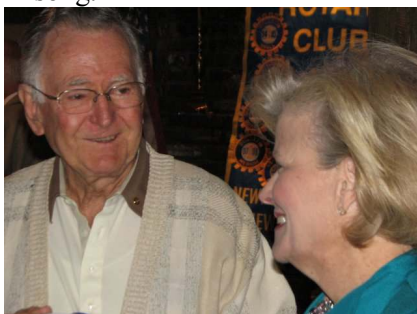

Today's Speaker



Marilyn McDougle

Our October 20th program was presented by Marilyn McDougle of the Orange County's Sheriff's Department *Drug Abuse is Life Abuse* program.

The program was founded 20 years ago to prevent drug abuse. It originally targeted juveniles. However it has been expanded, since many gangs include both juveniles and adults.

A major problem today is prescription drug abuse. Currently more deaths occur from prescription drug abuse than from illegal drug abuse. Some teenagers obtain the prescription drugs by raiding their parent's medicine cabinet or from their grandparents who leave them unattended on the kitchen counter. Also some over-the-counter drugs are dangerous if taken in excess. Some web sites on the Internet give directions on how to get a "buzz" by taking

large amounts of over-the-counter drugs.

Marijuana continues to be a problem. Varieties on the market today are 25 times more powerful than in 1960. Medical marijuana stores are more of a problem in Los Angeles County than in Orange County. Of all the drugs available methamphetamine is most addictive.

The Sheriff's *Drug Abuse is Life Abuse* program has reduced the number of gang members in Orange County. Law enforcement officers work with probation officers and other County Departments to achieve this objective.

We should make it more difficult to get access to prescription drugs and have a zero tolerance for access to alcohol.
