Since its inception in 1994, Laura's House has been committed to providing domestic violence-related programs and services to individuals and families in need. For the past fourteen years, Laura's House has provided shelter and support services to more than 2,000 battered women and children along with counseling, life skills education and legal assistance services to over 25,000 victims. Domestic violence is a serious and growing social issue and is the leading cause of injury to women nationwide, crossing all socioeconomic levels and ethnicities. The need for the services that Laura's House provides far exceeds the available social and financial resources required to effectively help the staggering number of victims. In 2008, Laura's House answered more than 1,700 hotline calls and sheltered over 200 women and children, representing an increase of 25% and 60% in the number of women and children clients served, respectively, in 2007.
