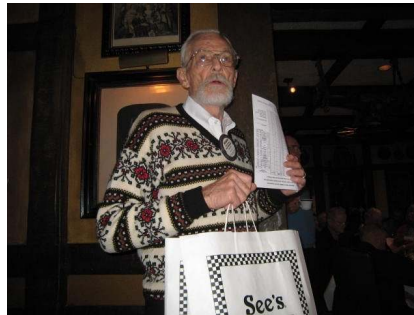
Donna Cody announced that the Annual **Corona Del Mar Christmas Walk** is scheduled for Sunday, December 5. Donna has raffle tickets for sale.

Cynthia Cowell introduced William Hahn, Project Manager of the Newport Beach Civic Center and Park being built. There will also be a 450 parking structure and an expansion on the library.

Mr. Hahn gave us a very informative slide presentation. The all glass building is designed to use as much natural light as possible. The building is a "Lead Silver Building". It is a user-friendly facility. The balconies give a great view of the ocean. The building will not disrupt the view of the neighbors on the other side of MacArthur. They are currently at the mass excavation phase. One truck leaves every minute or approximately 20,000 trucks hauling out dirt. The targeted budget is \$105 Million. The north end of the project will be a dog park and viewing area with additional parking.

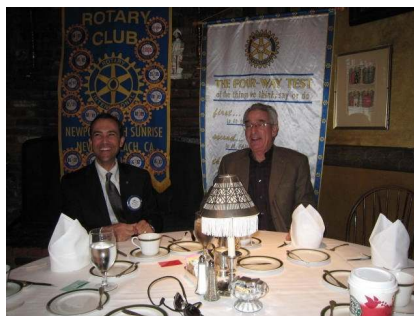
