President Cynthia Cowell introduced Past District Governor and current Chair for Rotary Foundation. Roger spoke to us about the three Avenues, Annual Programs Fund. The money in this fund is invested for three years and the interest earned is used to defray administrative cost. One half of these funds come back to District 5320. As Rotarians we should all think about making the Rotary Foundation our charity of choice. Rotary Facts is a publication that explains it all. District 5320 is the second district to be a 100% Paul Harris Fellow in the world. To be a member of the Paul Harris Society you must contribute \$1,000 every year. The Permanent Fund's goal is to have \$1 Billion by 2025. You can leave \$1,000 through your Will or pay it now. He explained the Triple Crown. A Club is 100% Paul Harris Club with \$100 annual contributions by every member and make the Fund your beneficiary.
