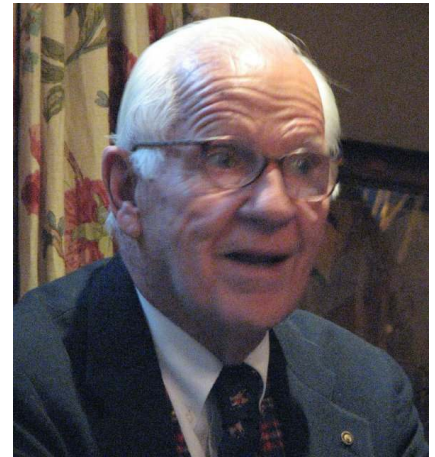
Club Assembly
