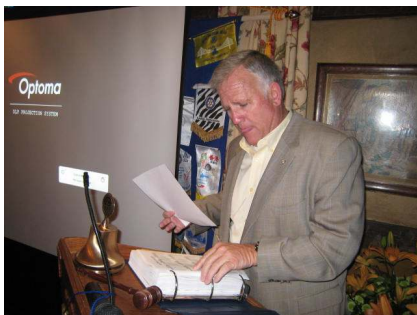

President Tim Brown enlightened us with the following milestones that occurred on May 25th:

1787 - In Philadelphia, PA, delegates convene a Constitutional Convention to write a new Constitution for the United States; George Washington presides.

1935 - Nuclear testing: At the Nevada Test Site, the United States conduct their first and only nuclear artillery test.

1953- The first public television station in the United States officially begins broadcasting as KUHT from the campus of the University of Houston.

1961 – Apollo program: U.S. President John F. Kennedy announces before a special joint session of the Congress his goal to initiate a project to put a "man on the Moon" before the end of the decade.

2001 – 32-year-old Erik Weihenmayer, of Boulder, Colorado, becomes the first blind person to reach the summit of Mount Everest.

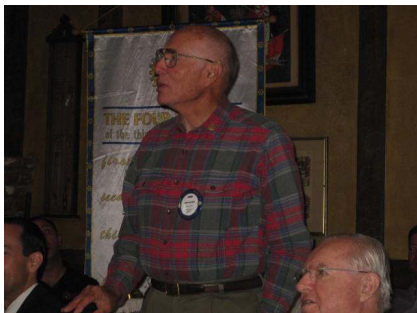

Cynthia Cowell introduced Tony Staser, the Special Events Manager for the Orange County Ronald McDonald House. Prior to joining the Orange County Ronald McDonald House, Tony was Director of Corporate Relations with the American Heart Association in Los Angeles and Director of Development with the National Psoriasis Foundation in Portland, Oregon.



Tony previously served as Vice President of Development for Women for World Health. In this role he made two trips to Africa to set up medical missions in Nigeria and Sierra Leone. Tony worked with Rotary International to set up one of these missions in Yola, Nigeria

Tony joined the Ronald McDonald House team in December 2009. He is responsible for the Walk for Kids program, an Annual Charity Golf Tournament, a High Tea and Fashion Show, as well as the Hearts for the House campaign each February. The Ronald McDonald Houses are not owned or operated by McDonalds. They care for families who have seriously ill children. They are a worldwide organization with 298 houses in 30 countries with 39 houses in the United States. In Southern California there are 6 houses and 1 camp.

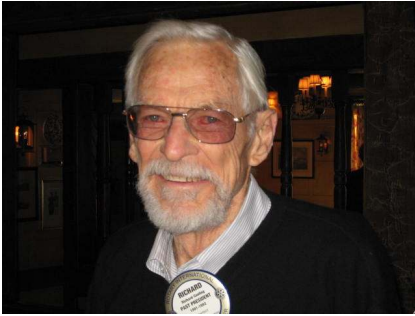
