### Judge Matt Anderson, Harbor Court

Pam Iles introduced Judge Matt Anderson who was her partner at South Court. Judge Anderson told us of the problems caused by the Wednesday furlough and the Laguna Niguel courthouse closing, which brought all the cases to Newport Beach. Newport Beach Harbor Court is now 100% criminal and traffic.

Drug Court is a collaboration that includes the Superior Court, the District Attorney, the Public Defender, the Probation Department, the Health Care Agency's Alcohol and Drug Abuse Services, and local law enforcement. Additional resources are provided by the nonprofit Drug Court Foundation of Orange County. People use Drug Court because it works!

The District Attorney has made a decision not to prosecute certain cases. Judge Anderson has been presiding over Drug Court for more than 10 years now. He was appointed by Governor Pete Wilson.
