**Fundraiser/Save the Date**

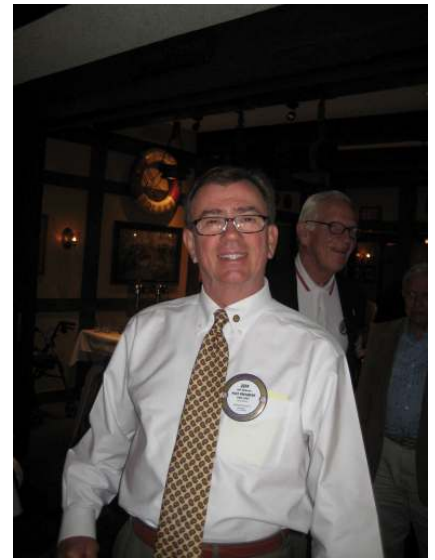

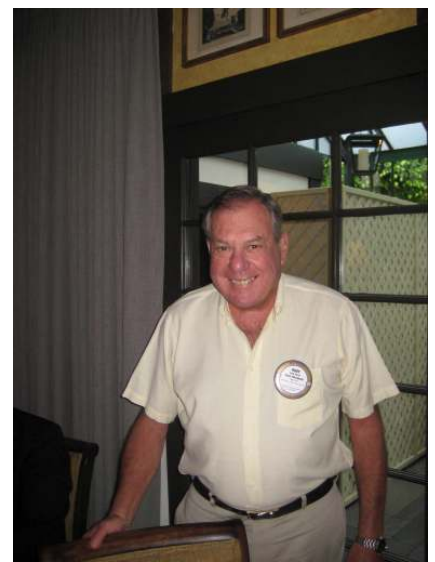
Steve Bender announced that the **Back Bay Cleanup** is scheduled for Saturday, September 17<sup>th</sup> and that Rotarians will be cooking
