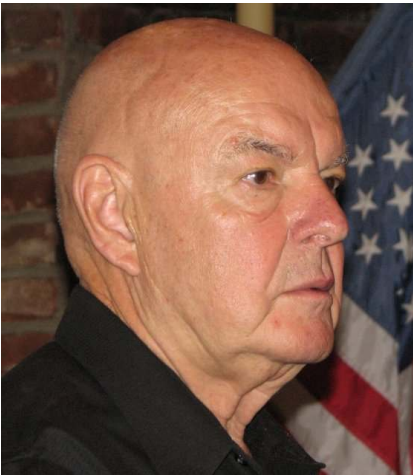

Marine 1/1 Car Wash on Saturday, Aug 21

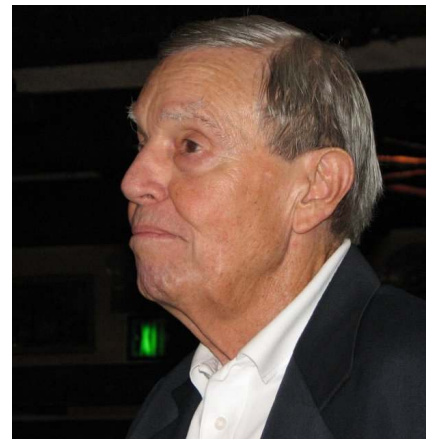

Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation

Carl Lachman introduced Barbara Rothman, President of the Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation. Barbara, who started out as a teacher, gave us a little background on herself. She became an advisor on the Board of Directors of the Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation before she retired from teaching. She thanked our Club for its continuing support. The Foundation was started in 1982 by people in the community and their first project was a special reading program. Today their project is "Grants for Teachers" Program. Newport-Mesa Schools Foundation is a nonprofit, all volunteer, community-based organization that promotes private support for public education in the Newport-Mesa Unified School District by raising funds for programs. She told us how the grant applications are reviewed and approved. Parents can honor teachers by donating \$50 and the teacher will be recognized. In the last 3 years they have given \$250,000 each year.

A book will be donated to Newport Beach Library in the name of Barbara Rothman.
