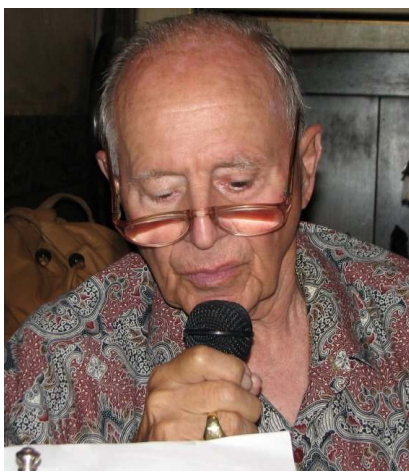

Joint Meeting with Newport-Irvine Rotary

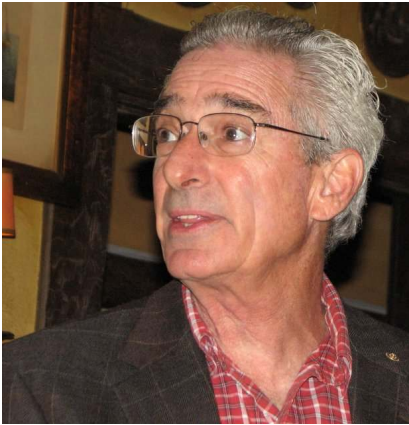

President Reniero Francisco introduced Bill Robbins. Bill was born in San Bernardino and raised in Colton, CA. He attended Stanford and served in the Military for 6 months. He worked at Kaiser Steel in Oakland then in their Los Angeles offices. He then worked in Philadelphia in tractor manufacturing sales, and ended up with a trucking line in Salt Lake City. He and his partners found themselves in the airplane transport business with a Forest Service contract. Bill married his college sweetheart and they had 4 children and 9 grandchildren. After divorcing he remarried and his wife died. Eight years ago he married Marilyn. He is a former golfer, loves to sail, travel and bike ride. He is involved with CHOC, Performing Arts and Hoag.
