It is preferred that you email, or if necessary fax or mail, information to **both** Donna Cody and Willis Longyear.

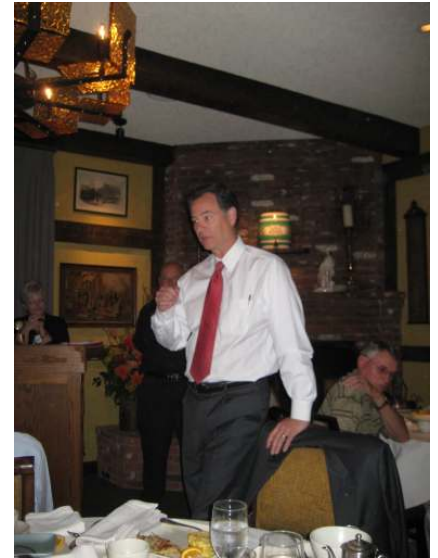

Wounded Warrior Battalion



Aaron Seibert

Laura Dietz introduced Aaron Seibert, today's speaker. Mr. Seibert is a recently retired, after 20 years, Navy Chief Petty Officer who was a medical corpsman assigned to the Marines. He served three tours in Iraq and in the third tour was seriously wounded by a mortar round that exploded near him.

He has been involved with the Marine Wounded Warrior Battalion for the last five years either as a patient or helping other patients. There are two Wounded Warrior Battalions. One on the West Coast and the other of the East Coast. When he became first was involved, the West Coast battalion had 12 members and now has 450 members supported by a staff of 180.

The Marines have many good support systems and different programs for the wounded. One of Mr. Seibert's activities was helping the wounded establish a new life style taking into consideration any limitations they might have because of their wounds.

He also discussed his experiences helping the civilians in Iraq and the lack of medical facilities available to Iraq civilians.

A book will be donated to the Newport Beach Public Library in the name of Aaron Seibert.
