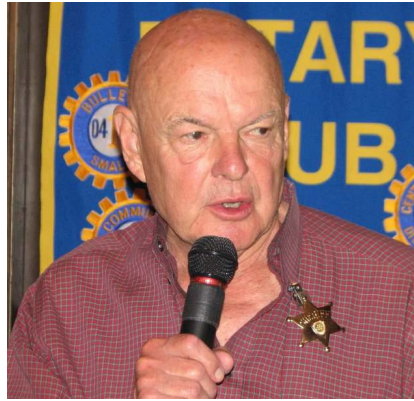
President Reniero Francisco reported that the Taste of Newport was a big success this year and they raised over \$203,000 for the Chamber of Commerce.

Visiting Rotarian and Assistant District Governor Dan Graham announced that Coto de Caza is holding an "Ethics in Business

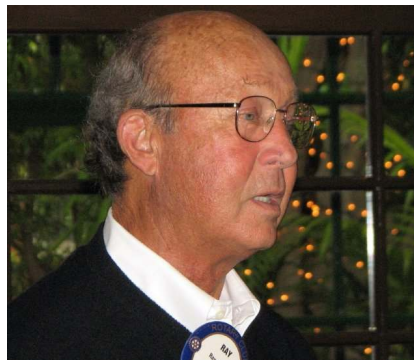
Awards" breakfast on Wednesday, September 29th. Everyone is welcome to attend to see how it is run.

President Reniero Francisco introduced Johrita Solari, District Governor of District 5320. District 5320 has 46 clubs with 2,070 members all located within 30 miles of each other, in Orange County and the best part of Los Angeles County. Johrita has been a Rotarian since 1993, joining the Rotary Club of East Anaheim. She served as Secretary, Treasurer, and served as President 1995-96. Johrita is currently a member of the Rotary Club of Anaheim. She reported that the RI President Ray Klinginsmith is doing things differently. His 3 Bs for Rotary are "Bigger, Better, Bolder". There is now a membership coordinator and a foundation coordinator. Their goal is to give Clubs the resources and tools to meet their Club goals. Our Club goal is 5 net new members. The RI Foundation goal is for every Rotarian to give \$200. She also reported that the "End Polio Now" campaign started over 25 years ago and today there are only 4 countries in the world with new cases.

District Governor Johrita Solari commended our Club for all its efforts in the community and internationally. She presented President Reniero Francisco with a picture of his Class of Presidents with RI President Ray Klinginsmith and with a stuffed Mickey the Mouse good doer! Reniero presented Johrita Solari with a small gift.
