**Orange County Sheriff**



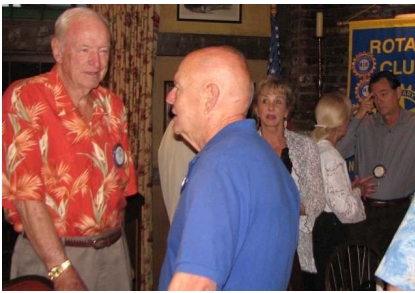
Orange County Sheriff, Sandra Hutchens
