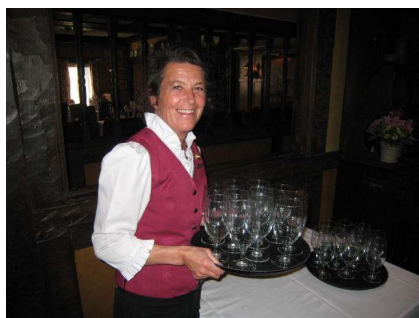

Half of the group have college degrees including one from Stanford. There is also an attorney and a chef. Phil Reynolds was our Guest Coach on Saturday.

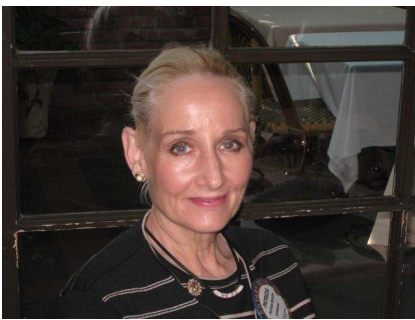
