Budget issues – pensions. They have just finished 2 years of a 3-year plan. City employees are down to 760.

Negotiations with safety groups representing the lifeguards, fire fighters and police.

Civic Center project, which is now 15 months from completion and on budget.

Status of the dredging project in the Bay.

Lower Bay dredging with the help of federal money.

The Q&A portion brought up the following topics:

Airport status and regulations of the smaller jets, which cause the noise.

The Irvine Company and the Airport.

Improvements of the building permit process.

Marina Park progress and the American Legion

Battle with recovery living homes in the city.

Homeless in Orange County.

The oil fields in Newport Beach.

Revenue streams for the city include property taxes, sales taxes, hotel bed tax and income properties.
