Willis Longyear introduced Dr. Hans Linhardt.. Dr. Linhardt was a member of this Club 10 years ago and served as its president. He is the President of his consulting business, LTDI, Inc., specializing in providing technical expertise to the worldwide industrial energy industry.

On the way to founding LTDI, Dr. Linhardt amassed over 50 years of experience working for internationally renowned corporations involved in industrial gas-processing, petrochemical refining, power and processing equipment, including projects varying from \$300 Million to \$1.6 Billion in size. He has received 15 U.S. patents, has published over 400 technical and business papers, and has lectured at leading U.S. Universities.
