Roger McGonegal, District Governor



President Mary Cockley introduced Roger McGonegal, District Governor of District 5320, well known to many of us. Roger started by stating that every day 25,000 children die from preventable causes. RI President DK Lee has challenged Rotarians to give these children a chance at a future. Before we can help them we must help ourselves - new Rotarians is the key. He told us about a "New Generations" Rotary Club in San Diego where the average age of members is 31. The District goal for the Paul Harris Foundation this year is \$240 per member. Rotary is now 103 years old. He told us about the donation of \$100 Million made by the Gates Foundation and how Rotary agreed to match those funds. Rotary should not be a secret any more. We, as Rotarians, need to spread the word about what Rotary does in our community and around the world. He talked about our literacy programs, the books collected at the International Convention and at the Orange County Fair. Leadership development is something we owe our new members. Roger told us that the District Assembly this Rotary year is scheduled for April 4, 2009 and

recommended we look at the website www.matchinggrants.org where they are looking for partners for various projects. April 25, 2009 is set for "Rotarians at Work" day. The District Conference will be held March 27 thru 29, 2009 and the location will be announced soon. Rotarians are volunteers and Rotary needs dedicated people so enjoy and share the fellowship of Rotary.
