Reducing Violence Against Women

Gordon Bagne introduced our speaker, John Chaffetz, Author and Speaker.



John Chaffetz

Mr. Chaffetz was born in Washington DC, graduated from Penn State and was a fighter pilot in the Air Force. He has owned a car/truck dealership, was an ABC Sports telecaster, in partnership of Elton John and now lives in Dana Point. He served on a jury, as foreman, for a trial that lasted 5 1/2 weeks. It was after this trial that he decided to write a book on the trial. Every female is an audience for the book. Seven and one-half months later the book was done. He now has written three books: The Personals Predator, Gay Reality and The Sex War.

Today is his 303 speaking appearance this year and his topic is reducing violence against women. He has spoke around the globe. Women are overly trusting and there is a woman raped every 2 1/2 minutes in the United States alone. The violence against women is completely out of control. He has spent time in the prison system to do his research and found that level 4 inmates are the monsters. Prisoners talk about their crimes, that is how they learn how to become better criminals. Sex offenders, however, do not talk about their crimes, that is how they protect themselves from other prisoners. He asked every prisoner he interviewed "How did you pick your victims?" He received the same answer every time: They did not have a criteria. They don't care what a woman looks like or her age. Rape is

not about the victim, it is about power and control. He warns every women to be careful, be aware because there is evil all around. Every single victim is damaged and it never goes away. Sex offenders must register and there are 100,000 plus in California and the state admits that 30,000 plus have been "lost". So if they admit to 30,000 then the figure is probably closer to 50,000 and they could be anywhere. Orange County has the number one crime lab in the United States and they have developed "touch trace" which even better than DNA. However, there are 300,000 to 500,000 untested rape kits in the US. Even with the federal money given to cities, counties, etc to do the testing, it has not been done. Why? He recommended that we all contact our Congressman and/or Senator and demand that the testing be done. You will when a victim is someone you care about. Mr. Chaffetz stayed to answer questions and sign books.

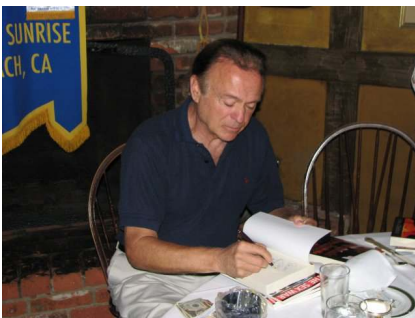
