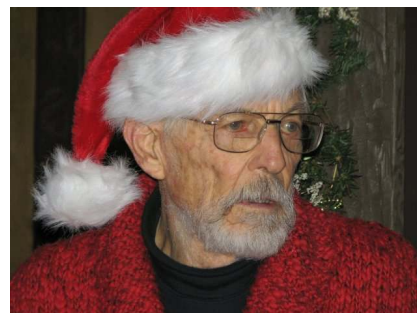

David Bahnsen announced is making good on his pledge to take those members who obtained corporate sponsors, etc to our fundraiser to dinner at the Ritz after the holidays.



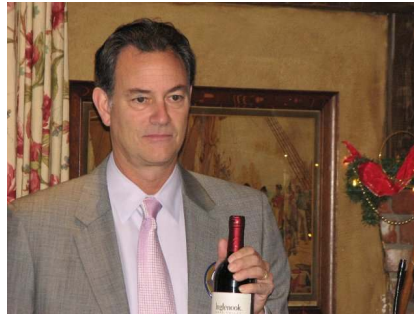

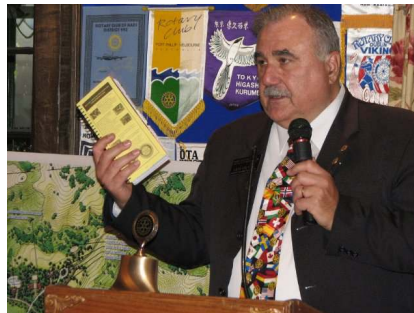

Gordon Bagne introduced Past District Governor Lane Calvert, Skip Seagraves, Director of Development and Amber Walker from the Orange County Council, Boy Scouts of America.

The Boy Scouts and Rotary have a very long history together. Lane told us about the 2009 Friends of Scouting Kick-Off Dinner scheduled for Thursday, February 26, 2009 at the Irvine Marriott Hotel. The keynote speaker will be Colonel Rick Searfoss, U.S.A.F., Astronaut and Space Mission Commander. He became an Eagle Scout in 1970.

Skip Seagraves talked about the new outdoor education center situated on land donated by the Irvine Company consisting of 210 acres adjacent to the Irvine Regional Park. It is one-of-a-kind education and recreational opportunity for the youth and families of Orange County to experience the area's natural beauty. This year-round facility will provide an opportunity for children of all ages to appreciate, respect and enjoy the region's natural environment through first-hand wilderness experiences. It is a \$30 Million dollar project which will open in January.
